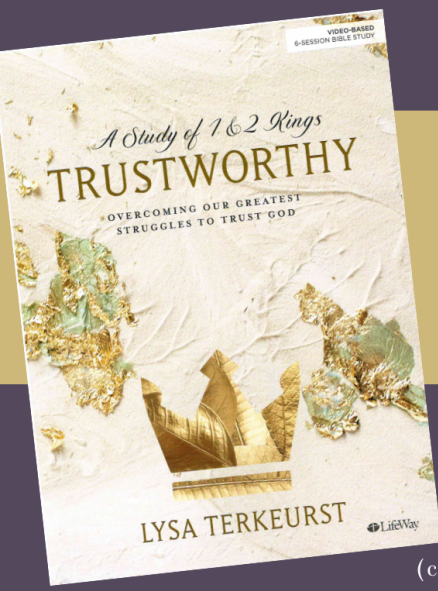
GIVING BACK AT THANKSGIVING AND CHRISTMAS

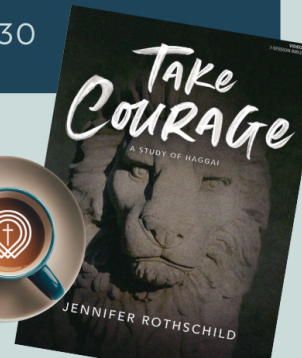
