## VISION CAMPAIGN BUILDING UPDATE

*Investing in the next generation to be equipped for ministry*

CrossPoint's vision for expansion took another step forward in February when voting members approved the sale of a 2.9 acre land parcel to fund the construction of a new ministry building. With \$1.5 million already pledged to the Vision Campaign, we're humbled by your generosity. Your continued support is invaluable as we move forward together in realizing our vision.

Here's a snapshot of what's been happening in February:

- We praise God for an agreement with the City of Chino to continue to lease out the 2.88 acres on Euclid Avenue through the end of 2024.
- Information is being gathered to assess the value of the land so that it can be listed for sale. We hope to have it on the market this month.
- We are working with the architect on a mutually acceptable agreement to move forward with plans for the new ministry building.
- We continue to explore other ideas that might allow us to raise funds to move forward with the ministry building sooner without selling the land.

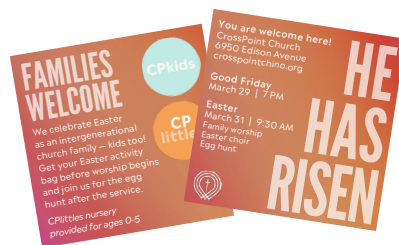
