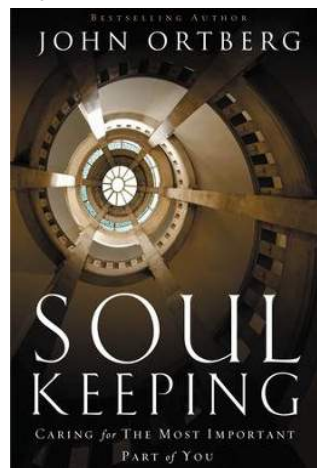

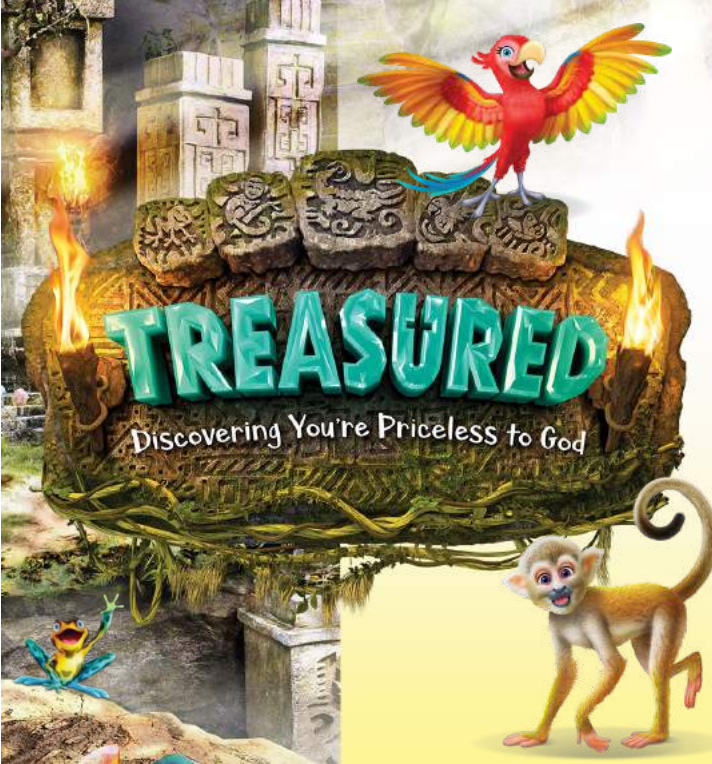
PROFESSION OF FAITH CLASS

John Calvin: The Apostles' Creed “furnishes us with a full and every way complete summary of faith, containing nothing but what has been derived from the infallible word of God.”

Creed = A short and basic statement of essential beliefs of the Christian Church.

Confessions = An elaborate statement of denominational theological distinctives.

Catechism = Instruction in the Christian faith often given in preparation for baptism or first communion.
