READ THE STORY. EXPERIENCE THE BIBLE.

We've gone through the first 6 chapters of The Story and learned about what happened in the beginning. This Sunday, the second section of The Story begins, as God's people begin settling in the land. In Chapter 7, we find that following God involves engaging in an ongoing series of battles to live in His will and walk in His ways. That will always be part of the story.

REFORMATION DAY

A single event on a single day changed the world. It was October 31, 1517 and a young Martin Luther nailed 95 statements on the door of a church in Germany, beginning a debate that would spark a theological and cultural reformation. As a result of the Reformation, today we celebrate the beauty of the gospel of Jesus Christ and our salvation by grace alone. The five solas below reflect the key elements of the Reformation, and we hope you experience them in your life today and every day.
